


Hub of Hope signage guidance: Network Rail





#### Overview

Chasing the Stigma have designed printed, digital, and social media assets which can be downloaded from the <a href="Network Rail campaigns page">Network Rail campaigns page</a>.

These are ready to use in any of your billboards, ticket machines, escalators, platforms, toilets, and staff workspaces.

The QR codes used in these designs can be tracked to monitor how many people are scanning them to access the Hub of Hope directly from signposting on the rail network.

It is recommended that Train Operators are in full support when placing signage in stations and can advise staff and cleaning contractors of their legitimacy to avoid removal.



#### Guidance

Hub of Hope signage should not be installed in close proximity to other materials to avoid sensory overload.

Hub of Hope signage is designed to highlight available support to those who are not currently in crisis. As such, these should not be placed at platform ends, and should instead be installed at locations where they are visible to the casual observer.

High footfall locations that are ideal for posters and digital screens:

- Station entrances
- Ticket offices
- Waiting rooms/shelters
- Routes to platforms

Posters have been produced onto Foamex and Vinyl and used across the North West and Central region.

Hub of Hope Stickers are smaller and are ideal for locations where people are stood or seated. Some examples of good locations are:

- Ticket machines
- Waiting shelters and benches
- Backs of toilet doors
- Lifts


